Thus, although the main focus will be on Old and Middle English, feel free to present papers also on Celtic, Latin, Old Norse, and Anglo-Norman.

Abstracts of 250 words should be submitted by the end of the year 2011 to conference-prague@seznam.cz. The presentations should not be longer than 20 minutes. We also encourage proposals for panels (three twenty-minute or four fifteen-minute papers).

Those who do not wish to present a paper are welcomed as well as the conference is meant to create a meeting opportunity for those interested in the subject.
