He is author of *Translating Ireland: Translation*, *Languages, Identities* (Cork University Press, 1996) and *Across the Lines: Travel, Language and Translation* (Cork University Press, 2000) which was awarded the CATS Vinay-Darbelnet Prize. He is co-editor of *Unity in Diversity: Current Trends in Translation Studies* (St. Jerome 1998) and *Reinventing Ireland: Culture, Society and the Global Economy* (Pluto Press, 2002). His research interests are Irish translation history, translation and travel, and translation and globalization.
